Following the results of an initial consultation held earlier this year, residents are being asked to influence the evolution of their communities by giving South Northamptonshire Council (SNC) their comments on the Community Governance Review (CGR).

Emma Faulkner and Louise Aston (Law and Governance, South Northants & Cherwell District Council) will be attending the meeting to discuss this and try to answer any concerns regarding the Brackley/Evenley boundary proposal.

The consultation runs from 30th October to 8th December 2017 and full details on how to take part will be available.

116/17 Northamptonshire County Council cuts

Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) is exploring the possibility of cuts to some services that will affect all communities in the county. The news was based on a report on the council's Medium Term Financial Plan that had been published for the NCC Cabinet meeting that was held yesterday. The report is available at:

The recommendation in the report was that the proposals be consulted on, and this was agreed at the Cabinet meeting. A public consultation will begin in November and a detailed plan is being drawn up for how that will work.

The proposals relate to 2018/19, i.e. for the financial year that starts in April 2018.

The proposals that will be of most interest to parish and town councils are:

Remove subsidies for bus services where there is no statutory duty to provide them

Remove Empowering Councillors and communities fund of £5k per councillor

Redesign of Libraries including withdrawal of the mobile library and the closure or transfer to the community of some medium and smaller libraries (3 options to be consulted on)

Remove parish enhancement grant

Reduced weed killing treatment, reduction in road marking maintenance and targeted traffic signal maintenance

Reduce winter gritting to 32% of the network and charge parishes for filling grit bins

Reduce Public Right of Way technical, inspection, enforcement and operational staff levels
