

Annual Parish Meeting – 16th April 2018

Evenley Parish Council Financial Statement

During the course of the year, the parish had an income of £28,573.00 which included the following:

- Precept payment from South Northamptonshire Council (SNC) of £19,836.00
- Transparency grant from Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) of £360 (to help with website/administration fees)
- Donations from Evenley Matters and Evenley Cricket Club (towards a new picnic bench) of £410.00
- New Homes Bonus local community grant (towards two new street lamps in Church Leys) of £2758.00
- SNC Community Infrastructure Levy funding of £2876.20 (towards two new street lamps in Lawyers Close)
- Northants ACRE winner's prize of £250.00 (for a planter outside the village hall)

Expenditure came in at £25,228.00

This included:

- £7893.00 on streetlighting electricity & maintenance
- £2567.00 on grass-cutting, tree care and allotments
- £414.00 on hiring Evenley Village Hall for meetings, soup lunches & CPR training
- £150.00 to refill three EPC owned grit bins
- £485.00 on a new picnic bench
- £360.50 on clerk & councillor training
- £8962.63 on administration including audit charges, insurance, subscriptions, printing, phone calls, newsletter and wages

The accounts will be internally audited by John Marshal of NCALC on 2nd May and will be made available to the public between June and July 2018.
