

Annual Parish Meeting – 3rd April 2017

Evenley Parish Council Financial Statement

During the course of the year, the parish had an income of £17,672.32 which included a precept payment from South Northamptonshire Council (SNC) of £13,813.00, a Transparency Grant from Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) of £2481.65 to help with website fees and equipment, plus a donation from Evenley Matters to enable the parish council to plant bulbs around the village.

Expenditure came in at £19,130.00

This included:

- £2844.49 on streetlighting electricity & maintenance (up 60%)
- £2090.00 on grass-cutting, tree care and the emergency allotment well safety repair (up 35%)
- £460.00 on hiring Evenley Village Hall for meetings, soup lunches & CPR training (up 50%)
- £634.00 on a grant to Evenley Village Hall Management Committee (new)
- £614.00 on Traffic Control Systems (new)
- £1070.00 on the set up of the village website (up 77%)
- £230.00 on Clerk & Councillor training (down 71%)
- £9097.76 on administration including audit charges, insurance, subscriptions, printing, phone calls, newsletter and wages (up 41%)

The accounts will be internally audited by John Marshal of NCALC on 18th May and will be made available to the public between June and July 2017.
