

Malus Evereste



Malus 'Evereste'

'Everest' has a compact, broadly round, tidy crown making it an excellent choice for smaller gardens. White flowers open from dark pink buds in spring followed by orange and red blushed crabapples that persist into winter. Leaves emerge green in spring and remain so until autumn when they transform into orange and yellow. Hardy. Slow growth rate, height at maturity (after twenty years) approx six metres.

Malus Floribunda



Malus floribunda

Very popular small tree with long, arching branches. Remarkably beautiful when in bloom. Crimson buds open to white or pale blush flowers, smothering the tree in April-May. These are followed by small red or yellow fruits that persist well into winter. Mid green leaves turn yellow and bronze in autumn. Pollutions tolerant. Hardy. Moderate growth rate. Height at maturity (after twenty years) six to ten metres.
