



Our annual requirements for exclusive use of the Village Green during 2023 are:

#### Maintenance of the Square/Wicket

Regular ongoing maintenance of the wicket from March to September inclusive, including roping off the square at times to protect the wicket following maintenance and after matches. The square is also covered during periods of adverse weather leading up to a match.

#### Cricket net on the Green – (April to September inclusive)

Erected in the corner of the green by the shop and used on an ad hoc basis for practice sessions. It is open to residents to use exclusively for cricket practice, at their own risk, save for during coaching and matches organized by E.C.C. The net is erected in April and taken down in September.

#### Every Saturday from April 29th to 2<sup>nd</sup> September (12 noon onwards)

To accommodate our commitment to competitive league cricket fixtures in the SNCL – South Northants Cricket League. Failure to comply will result in fine and point deduction for the affected team.

#### Every Sunday morning from May to August inclusive (10am – 12 noon)

To provide organized and supervised coaching to the junior section of E.C.C.

#### Weekday evenings from May to August inclusive – (5pm – 9pm)

To accommodate our commitment to competitive cricket in the South Northants Junior Cricket League. The evenings of the week vary depending on which age group teams we have entered into the league each season.

#### Occasional Sunday friendly fixtures – (12 noon onwards)

To accommodate requests from Evenley and Mixbury residents to host friendly fixtures: ie Luke Williams memorial match, The Sticky Wickets etc.

All fixtures are confirmed and circulated through the E.C.C fixture book, published in April each season, and/or posted on the E.C.C and relevant league websites.
